1. Objectives of Education and Admission Policy

Objectives of	The objective of this program is to educate and train students to
Education	become professional practitioners who can (1) play active roles in creating new bioindustry technologies and effectively manage bioresources, (2) appropriately handle intellectual property rights, and (3) meet with the global standard regarding international strategy and policy determination. This education is based on a curriculum focusing on teaching students broad and specialized knowledge and raising their abilities to play an active role in various fields of bioindustry.

	program has been established in our program as a special course
	for the English program. It develops internationally competitive
	human resources over multi-disciplinary practices with technology and science components, as well as legal, regulatory, social, and
	ethical aspects for bioindustry promotion. The educational aim of
	this program is to cultivate doctorate holders who can work as
	practitioners involved in the sustainable development and improvement of life sciences; focusing on food, resource,
	medicine, energy development, and environmental conservation
	technologies, to which great importance is acknowledged in the
	21st century. In contrast to graduate programs in conventional universities, which generally focus on academic career paths, this
	program aims to cultivate practical researchers who can respond to
	the needs of strategy and policy making from an international perspective. Through education and research fields that integrate
	natural science and social science, this program seeks to cultivate
	special practitioners who can contribute to the creation of novel
	life industries. Students are expected to acquire knowledge and skills based on global standards that are needed for the acquisition
	and distribution of biological resources, as well as securing of
	intellectual properties.

2. Entrance Examination Schedule

The entrance examination schedule is as follows:

- (1) Online Application Period: From December 1st, 2023, to December 8th, 2023
- (2) Submission of Required Documents: No later than December 15th, 2023
- (3) Individual Interviews: January 25th, 2024
- (4) Announcement of Decision on Application: February 15th, 2024
- (5) Enrollment Procedures: Late June 2024 to late August 2024
- (6) Enrollment Dates: October 1st, 2024

Individuals falling under either of the categories below may apply for this program:

- (1) Those who graduated or are expected to graduate from a graduate school by September 30th, 2024.
- (2) Those who have earned or expect to earn a specialized degree by September 30th, 2024.
- (3) Those who have been recognized eligible by the screening of Graduate School as having academic ability equivalent to or superior to those of university graduate and aged above 24-years old or will become 24-years old by September 30th, 2024.

6-3 (Expected) Graduation Certificate

Please submit the original graduation certificate (or certificate of expected graduation) issued by your university. No specific format is designated. Please include the date of your (expected) graduation.

6-4 (Expected) Degree Certificate

Please submit the original degree certificate (or certificate of expected completion) issued by your university. No specific format is designated. Please include the date of your (expected) completion.

6-5 Transcript

Please submit an original transcript. If you are currently attending graduate school, submit a transcript containing results of the past study period at graduate school. No specific format is designated. Please submit the original document, not a copy.

8. Selection method

After the application documents are received, screening will be conducted based on the submitted documents and individual interviews. In the individual interviews, a comprehensive evaluation will be made on English ability, basic knowledge, and eagerness to enter English Course "International Bioindustrial Sciences Course for Doctoral Program".

9. Announcement of Successful Applicants

Announcement of decision: February 15, 2024

Notification of the final result will be sent by email and post to all applicants. "Documents Required for Enrollment Procedures" at the University of Tsukuba will be mailed to accepted applicants.

10. Enrollment Procedures

(A) Time period

- (1) The time period for enrollment procedures is from late June to late August, 2024.
- (2) Following receipt of the "Documents Required for Enrollment Procedures," send all documents required for admission by international courier service by the above deadline.

(B) Payment required by students (except government scholarship students)

- (1) The normal admission fee is \$282,000.
 - The entrance fees are exempted for those who are the Government-Sponsored (Japanese Government Monbukagakusho scholarship) foreign students or who have completed the University of Tsukuba Master's Program and will continue on to the University Doctoral Program within one year of the completion date. (Based on the rules of the University of Tsukuba).
- (3) If the amount of payment is revised at the time of admission or during enrollment, the new amount will be applied from the time of revision.
- (4) The University offers, upon selection, a waiver of all or part of the tuition fee for students who are deemed to find it difficult to pay tuition due to financial reasons and for students who have other unavoidable circumstances.

11. Handling of Personal Information

Results from the entrance examination, as well as personal information obtained by the University of Tsukuba from the applicants' documents, will be used for affairs concerning admission and screening, or may be used to improve the way of admission and university education keeping each identity confidential.
